
9 people : 2 dancers, 2 musicians, 1 choreographer, 1 light manager, 1 sound manager, 1 stage manager, 1 tour coordinator



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Magma brings together, under the artistic direction of Christian Rizzo, two dancers, Marie-Agnès Gillot star dancer of the Paris Opera and Andrès Marin flamenco dancer around original musical compositions by Didier Ambact, Bruno Chevillon and Vanessa Court. Duration 1 hour.

Stage



- The decor consists of two V-shaped frames placed in the middle of the stage on white dance mats. At the deep courtyard end, a platform also covered with white mats welcomes the musicians. (See plot).
- Useful surface of 13 meters wide by 10 meters deep. Adaptations possible up to 11m wide.
- The white dance mats are to be provided by the venue to be placed in the garden courtyard and taped from below during the pre-assembly. We bring the white mats fittings to dress the stairs.
- We need 8 passable to make the staircase (Cf. plan). We provide the last module of 1 * 1 at H0.4m.
- Please provide that the staircase thus constituted is secure.
- Provide a staircase to access the distant courtyard.
- Side panels (surrounding with taps) and black drop
- The decor arrives by truck in 6 pieces of 4m by 1.75 m. 2 sheets weigh 80 Kg and the other 4 around 70 Kg, it is therefore necessary to provide 3 people for unloading in addition to our managers.
- Plan 1 cleaning per day.
- Please provide 3 rolls of gaffer additional white dance floor as well as a double sided roll.
- Enclosed fire resistance report (B-s1/d0)

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Sound

REGIE

Due to the live nature of the music in the show and the spatialization of the sound system, the sound management must be placed indoors, on the axis of the stage and clear of any balcony (minimum dimensions 2×1 meters).

- The console serves as an audio interface via the Dante Virtual Sound Card, The CL + Rio3224 association is therefore essential for the performance of the show.1 console de mixage Yamaha CL5/CL3 ou QL5
- 1 RIO 3224 Yamaha + câble RJ45 RIO > console

Sound diffusion

- 2 distant monitor Left/Right on stage, under-perched tray with black slings (2 x hp 15" type L. Acoustics X15).
- 2 side monitors J/C in front on stage under-perched or on a tripod h=1.80-2m (2 x hp 15" type L. Acoustics X15).
- 1 FOH hung Power and coverage adapted to the room.
- 2 2 subwoofers L/R on the same deepth than FOH, (hp 18" type L. Acoustics SB28).
- 2 side monitors L/R in audiance (2 x hp 15" type L. Acoustics X15)
- 2 monitors L/R back audiance (2 x hp 15" type L. Acoustics X15)
- 2 wedge monitors for musicians (2 x hp 15" L. Acoustics 15X HiQ)
